

Rules and Regulations for Human Weapon Tae Kwon Do

We, the instructors of Human Weapon Tae Kwon Do, respectfully ask that you abide by the rules and regulations listed below for the safety of yourselves and your children.

Please check off each paragraph, and sign the bottom of the page, to acknowledge your reading and understanding of the rules.

- Yellow belts and above are required to have fighting gear with them for every class. Students must bring it back and forth with them to each class. It is not to remain in the dojang. Fighting gear includes a helmet, gloves and feet. Students with out proper fighting gear will not be allowed to participate in sparring. This jeopardizes the student's ability for promotion.
- Proper uniforms are required for each student. It must be the tradition Chan-hon Taekwondo uniform with ITF and HWT crests and contain the proper belt. Care should be taken to ensure proper fitting and cleanliness of the uniform. The uniform may not be left at the dojang. Any equipment or uniforms left at the dojang will be considered communal property, and thrown out.
- Attendance at each class is encouraged. Missing a class jeopardizes the student's ability for promotion. There are no refunds for missed classes.
- Proper supervision will begin ten minutes prior to the start of class and conclude fifteen minutes after the end of the class. Parents should be as prompt as possible to ensure proper supervision of their children.
- Students that are disruptive or disrespectful will be asked to sit out the class. They are a danger to themselves and other students in the program. Frequent occurrences will result in possible suspension or expulsion from the program. No refunds will be given in such circumstances.
- Students are expected to attend testing programs even if they are not testing, as if it is a regular class. Students should come prepared with their uniforms and fighting gear. This encourages loyalty and solidarity of the students. They also may be needed for demonstrations purposes.
- Testing and promotions are not automatic. Proper technique, sufficient improvement, minimum attendance, and good behavior are all taken into consideration before testing and promotions.

Our program is taking place at a synagogue. At all times students and parents must take care to show respect to the property and the decorum due a place of worship. Services may take place during class time and therefore students must move through the building quietly. Behavior in the parking lot must be orderly and safe.

Parents should take care to position cars dropping off and picking up in a way that does not interfere with congregants arriving to or departing from services.
